We would be grateful if all owners of a barbet of 2 years or older would complete this health questionnaire for their dog, whether the dog is healthy or ill, or has passed away. The more people who participate, the more accurate a picture we will get.

All responses will be treated confidentially.

The responses for individual dogs will NOT be reported or disclosed.

We will summarise the results and make them available to all, in an easily understandable and clear format (percent, number, bar charts, etc..).

We will only present general results and not any individual response. Within the results no one will be able to see the response for any individual dog, nor if a dog comes from a particular kennel.

Please note, therefore, no individual's identity will be identifiable in the results.

The overall picture of the population is very important to the breed club (and thus to all of us) to get as accurate a picture as possible of the health situation, and be able to modify the guidelines for the breeding of the Barbet.

The purpose of this survey is therefore to have a well-founded summary of the situation across the breed in the UK, and not to focus on individuals.
